What is the objective of BACID Fund?

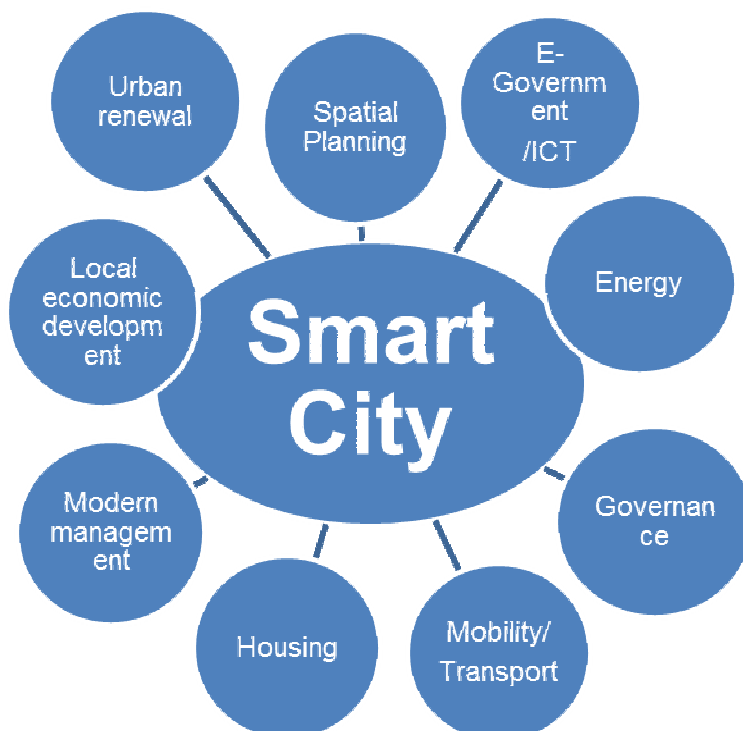
Strengthening administrative capacities in order to introduce and implement EU acquis relevant to local and regional governments from Austria to the following countries:

Three thematic priorities identified within the **Urban Platform Danube Region** established in the framework of the Priority Area 10 „Institutional Capacity and Cooperation“ of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region (EUSDR), shall be tackled by the BACID Calls. Besides Smart City, it covers **Sustainable City** and **Inclusive City** that include variety of topics in the competence of local and regional governments in line with Europe 2020 Strategy.

How much money is available?

Funds available in the first Call for Proposals:
Maximum available per Action

€ 30,000
€ 6,000

The Applicant have to ensure that all other costs of the action shall be covered in order to implement the Action successfully, with **obligatory own financial or in-kind contributions**.

What type of activities it finances?

- Expert support and mentoring
- Workshops, seminars and training
- Elaboration of reports, studies, surveys and other documents

What costs can be covered by BACID?

- Expert fees
- Expert per diems
- Expert travel costs

How to apply?

- More applications may be submitted by one applicant and awarded, under the condition that the proposed actions target different beneficiary countries.
- Partners can benefit from maximum 2 actions per Call for proposals: one related only to their beneficiary country and additionally one where partners from more countries are involved.
