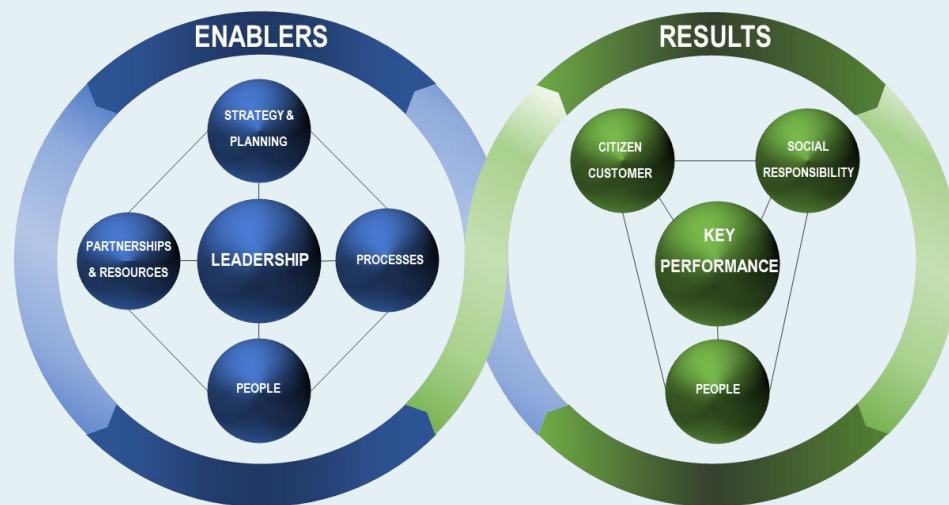
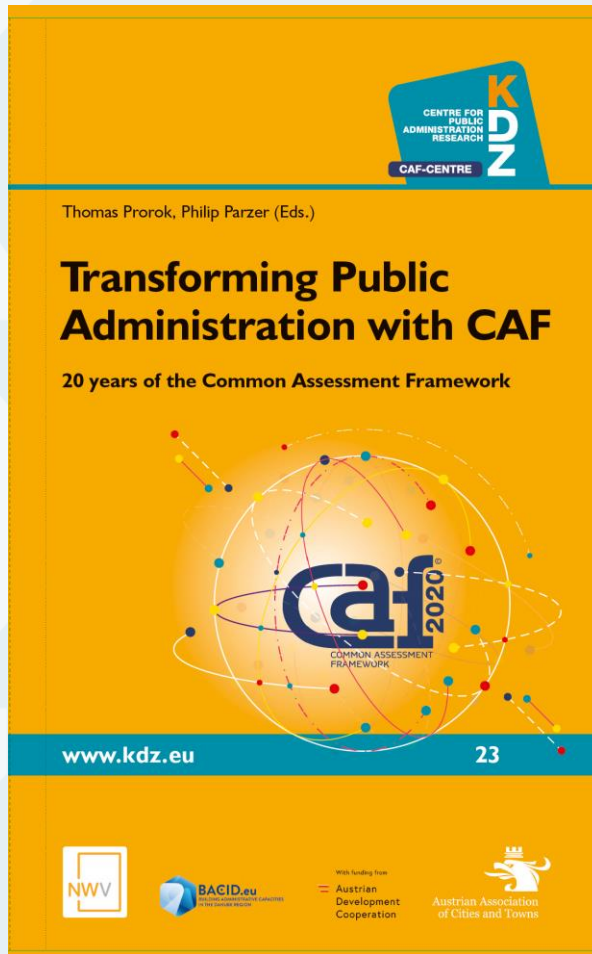

Challenges of CAF

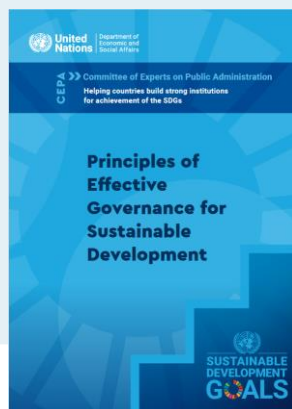
- ❑ **Different extent of CAF-usage in Europe**
 - Not all countries use CAF
 - No or changing national CAF structures
 - European institutions do not use the CAF
- ❑ **Dependency on external funding**
- ❑ **European CAF Network has no clear rules and link to EUPAN**
- ❑ **CAF is a “gated community”**
- ❑ **Label “Effective CAF User” is not attractive**
- ❑ **Minor prominence in European and International organizations**
